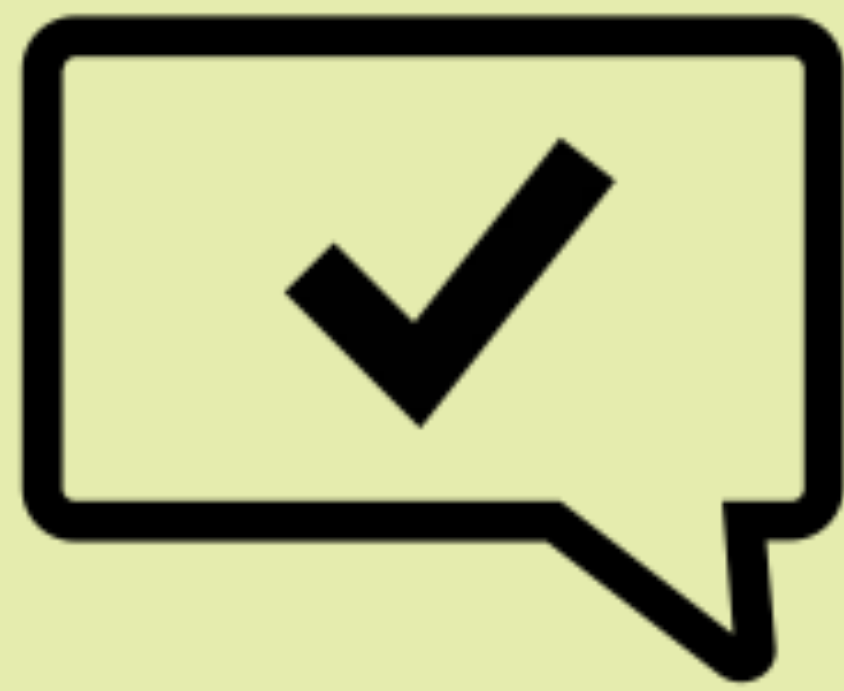

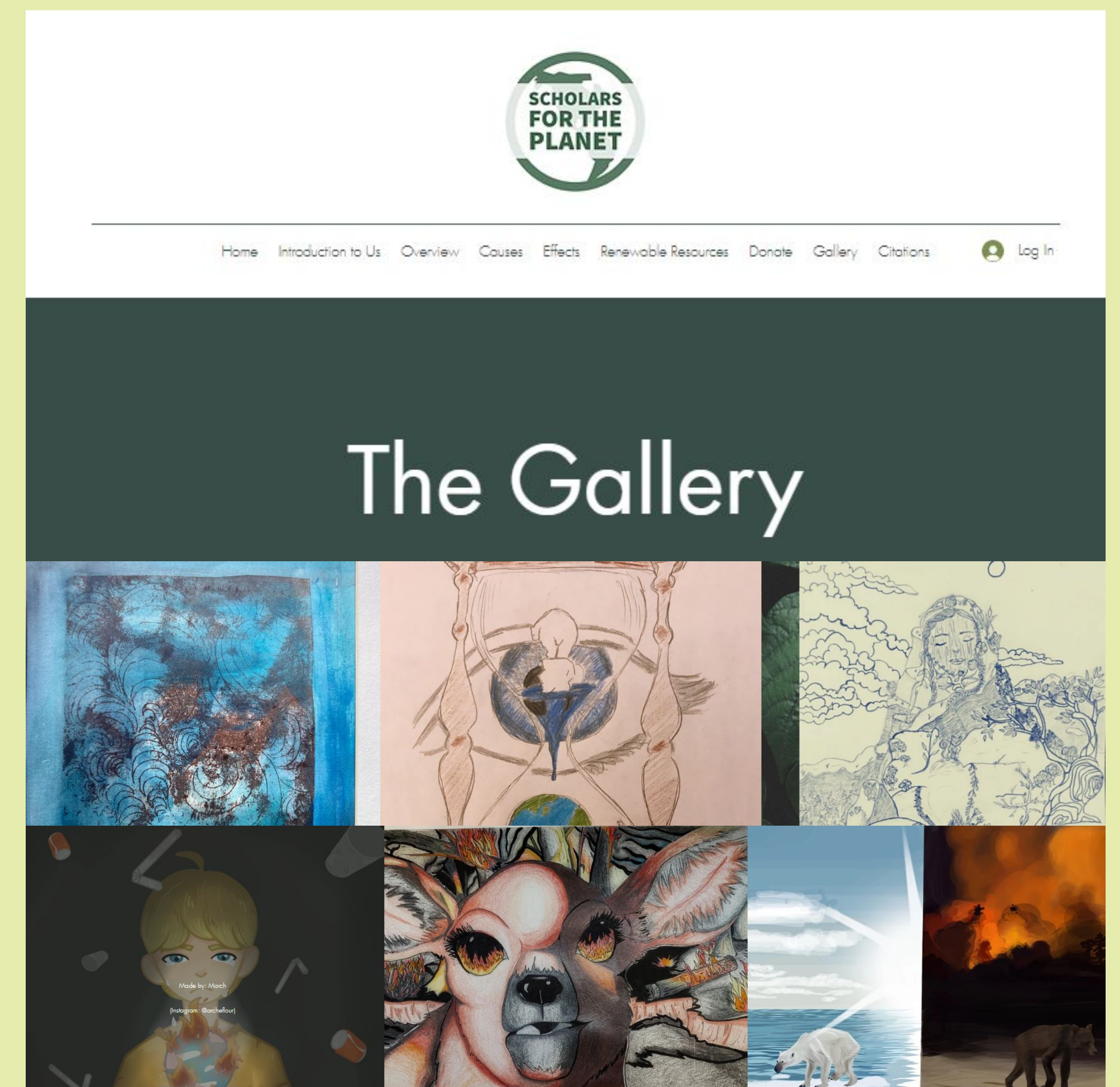
Building Awareness
